

German Short Wave Broadcast -- Feb 28, 1940

Announcer quoted Le Soleil to the effect that there
was no enthusiasm for the war, that many Canadian soldiers
had been forced into service, that equipment was insufficient,
clothing was poor and that there were morecases of sickness
among Canadian forces than there had ever been before. Further,
that
has French-speaking Canadians were not behind the Government
and that only British officials were enthusiastic for the war.
