The Chairman, in conveying to Mr. O'Meara a vote of thanks which had been passed, said the lecture had made all present feel that there was a serious question to be dealt with in this Province and one that they should all be anxious to see settled in a fair and honorable manner—a manner that would do credit to the Province and at the same time allay the suspicions and remove the dissatisfaction of their Indian fello w-subjects.
