cided by a majority of members present, ascertained by show of hands, the chairman having a casting vote.

**Questions** of Order

All questions of order shall be decided by the chairman, but any member present may appeal from his ruling, in which case the question shall be put without debate, "Shall the ruling of the chairman be sustained?" and decided in favor of the majority.

Membership

A list of members entitled to vote and eligible for election as officers shall be hung in a conspicuous place at the Annual Meeting.

The Secretary shall notify each candidate of his or her admission as member of the Society, sending a copy of the Constitution and Bylaws, and on receipt of ten dollars, which must be paid within three months after the election, and which will constitute the entrance fee and the annual fee to the following December 31st, the candidate shall become a member.

The Secretary shall, if possible, notify any member that has not sent pictures to the Annual Exhibition or paid his annual fee when due, and call his attention to Article VI of the Constitution.

Exhibitions.

The Hanging and Selection Committee shall be composed of three members of the Society elected at the December monthly meeting.

The decisions of this Committee shall be final.
