" tain Duties to His Majefly towards fupplying the wants of the Province during the " present War with the United States of America, and for other purposes;"-which faid Acts were to have expired on the first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighteen : May it therefore please your Majesty that it be enacted, and be it enacted, by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and c nfent of the Legiflative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain parts of an " Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Maiefty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for-" making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in " North America," and to make further provision for the government of the faid: " Province ;" and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, that all and; every the provisions, claufes, matters and things contained in the first above-mentioned Act, intituled, " An Act to grant certain Duties to His Majefty, towards fup-" plying the wants of the Province during the prefent War with the United States. " of America, and for other purpofes ;" fave and except fuch of the provisions, claufes, matters and things therein-contained as have been repealed and amended by. the above mentioned Act, paffed in the fifty-fifth year of His Majelty's Reign, intituled, " An A& to repeal part of, and amend an A& paffed in the fifty third year se of His Majefty's Reign, intituled, se An Act to grant certain Duties to His Majefty; " towards furplying the wants of the Province during the prefent War with the United 55 States of America, and for other purpofes," fhall, with all and every the provisions, claufes, matters and things, in the faid last recited A& mentioned and contained, continue to be, and remain in full force and effect; and the duties by the faid fift. mentioned Act imposed, shall continue to be raifed, levied, collected and paid, as inand by the faid Act it is specified and provided, except as in and by this Act it is. otherwise provided, until the fifteenth day of April, which will be in the year of: our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-three, and no longer.

Monies levied to remain in the bands of the Receiver General for the future disposition of the Provincial Parliament.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that the Monies levied under and in virtue of this A&, fhall be paid into the hands of the Receiver-General of this Province, and fhall there remain and be referved for the future disposition of the Legislature of this Province.

Application of the monies to be accounted for to the Grown.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that the due application of all Monies that shall be raised and levied under and in virtue of this Act, shall be accounted for to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the time being, in such manner and form as His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, shall direct.
