WHEREAS at a Session of the Parliament of Our Province of Canada, begun and holden at Our City of Toronto, in Our said Province, on the Twentieth day of May, in the fourteenth year of, Our Reign, and prorogued on the Thirtieth day of August, in the fifteenth year of Our Reign, two certain Bills, intituled : " *An Act to amend the Act for granting a Civil List to Her Majesty,*" and " *An Act to reduce the Salaries attached to certain Judicial Offices, in the cases therein mentioned, and to fix the Salaries of the Speakers of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly,*" were passed in the Legislative Council and Assembly, and were, at the prorogation of the said Session, on the Thirtieth day of August aforesaid, presented to the Right Honorable THE EARL OF ELGIN AND KINCARDINE, Our Governor General of Our said Province, for Our Assent thereto, who, in pursuance of the authority vested in him by a certain Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the Session thereof, held in the third and fourth years of Our Reign,
