1X. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for collector of Imthe Collectors of Impost within this Island, to go board and search on board of any Ship or Vessel, coming into any &c. Harbour, Port, River or Creek, or any part of the Coast of this Island, either before or after such Ship or Vessel comes to Anchor, to rummage and and remain on search all parts of such Ship or Vessel, so long as board whilst she shall remain in such Port or place, and to search harbour, and examine the Cargo, and to examine if they shall see fit, the Master upon Oath, touching the Cargo and examine and Voyage, and if the Master shall not truly masters on oath. answer or refuse to answer, the questions to be Penalty on masdemanded of him in such Examination, he shall ter refusing to forfeit the sum of One Hundred Pounds.

X. And be it enacted, That all Boats, Carriages All boats, carand Cattle made use of in the removal of any in removing Goods, liable to a forfeiture under this or any Act goods, whereon duty is not paid relating to the Provincial Revenue, shall be for- or secured, to be feited, and every Person who shall assist or be forfeited. otherwise concerned in the unshipping, landing or removal, or in the harbouring or concealing such Goods, or into whose hands or possession the same shall knowingly come, shall forfeit treble the value Penalty on persons assisting in thereof, or the penalty of One Hundred Pounds removing such at the election of the officer or person prosecuting, and the averment in any information on libel to be exhibited for the recovery of such penalty, that the officer or person prosecuting has elected, to sue for the sum mentioned in the information, shall be deemed sufficient proof of such election, without any other or further evidence of such fact.

XI. And be it enacted, That if any person Penalty on person sons assaulting shall by force or violence, assault, resist, oppose, or opposing molest, hinder or obstruct any officer of the Provincial Revenue, or other person employed as aforesaid, in the exercise of his office, or any person acting in his aid or assistance, such person being thereof convicted before any Court of Record in this Island, shall pay a fine not exceeding One hundred pounds, nor less than Fifty pounds,
