How Finely Kyte Has Proved His Charges

Despite the fact that the Meredith Duff Commission has not more than half completed its enquiry into the questions referred to it, the opposition newspapers have already decided that the charges as made by Mr. Kyte have been "proved to the hilt." Just to keep the record straight let us see where Mr. Kyte stands.

The official report of his speech in Parliament, as published by Hansard, deals with the matter of the division of profits by Yoakum and others as follows:

"I have here a summary of the amount that was actually divided between Yoakum, Lignanti and Allison." German Repulsed Another Attack on Verdun Front

Paris, May 18—Several attacks were made by German troops on the Verdun front last night in an effort to capture a redoubt at Avocourt. The Germans were repulsed each time. They lost heavily. French troops captured a German fort on the northeast slope of Hill 304.

German trenches north of Hill 287 were raided by French forces which killed or captured the occupants.

On the Verdun front, east of the Meuse, artillery on both sides was active during the night.

Two French aeroplanes dropped eighty more shells on the railway station at Metz on the night of May 16th.

Three Americans on Canadian Boat Reported Torpedoed

Washington, May 17—Three Americans were aboard the Canadian steamer Eretrea, which has been sunk, according to a cablegram from the United States Consul at La Rochelle, France, today.

While Lloyd's yesterday reported the steamer torpedoed, the Consul said she was sunk on Friday, "presumably by a mine," and that no member of her crew was injured.

Two British Airmen Killed.

London, May 18—Lieut. Selwin and Bateman, military aviators, were killed instantly today at Gosport, in Hampshire, near Portsmouth. The aeroplane in which they were flying dived from a height of 1,000 ft. The cause of the accident has not been determined. Both lieutenants were experienced aviators.

Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations.

THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency) on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within one mile of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.

As settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months out of three years, cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$300.

The act of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.

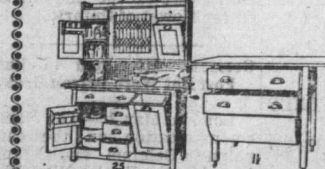
