



The same argument applies to stockers. The quieter the animal, the better he lays on flesh, which the above reasons prove. In this line the profit is greater than can be imagined without accurate fag ures. There is one more strong point in favor of dehorning: that is the danger to which attendants are exposed con-tinually when attending to cattle with horns, even by accident, to say nothing of ferocious attacks of the animals at times, or which not a few occurred in this very county. 
