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Court News

W. Theodore Davis of Fareham on the 11th was fined five dollars and \$8.50 costs in the local police court for carrying an offensive weapon, a .22 pistol without the license required by law. He was also fined \$1.00 and \$1.00 costs for selling a pistol without the necessary permit and \$10.00 and one dollar costs for assault on Joseph Chamberlain.

On the 18th J. F. Neilson had to pay five dollars for driving his auto without the necessary license plates on the front and back, as required by law. Fred Gibbs of Hill Spring fell into the same trap and also Axel Anderson of Taylerville, it cost them five dollars each.

H. J. Flock of Raley was also in the toils on the same charge on the night of the 25th. When driving a car the owner or driver must have the number plates on the car, promises are no good.

Upon information laid by Mr. Owen Williams, School Inspector, Hyrum Woodward of Aetna had to appear to answer for his son William not attending school and this cost him \$7.25, and the boy ordered to report regularly for school. It is but fair to Mr. Woodward to say that he was not aware that the boy was not attending school regularly. There are other cases to follow.

On the 18th the City Meat Market were rounded up by the Stock Inspector for omitting to send into the Provincial Government the necessary monthly reports of animals slaughtered. They had also failed to obtain a necessary license as hide buyers.

The authorities are now taking steps to abolish the use of flippers or catapults around the town and country. These have become a public nuisance and are very dangerous. We hear the school authorities have also been taking vigorous measures to abate the nuisance. These flippers are classed in the Criminal Code, Section 123, as offensive weapons and are absolutely illegal. They are also banned under Sec 58 of By-law 185 of the Town of Cardston. Citizens are justified in placing under arrest any boy caught using these things, and they should at once be turned over to the police.

Most chicken owners are considerate enough to keep their birds penned up at this time of the year when the seeding of gardens is general. There are, however, a few who have no regard for the rights of their neighbors and allow their fowls to run at large, scratching up newly seeded ground and devouring the seeds.

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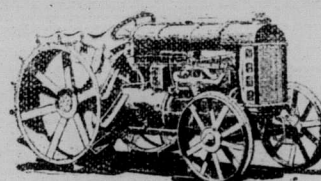
