Paris, April 30 .- Prof. Lannelongue has just described to the Academy of Science the case of a man afflicted with an unusual illness called osteomalachy, which in three years caused his stature to diminish from four feet six inches to less than three feet.

According to the physician, all the bones in the patient's body became softed and bent like rubber, and this condition lasted for more than three years, after which period the patient got well again without any apparent reason or cure, and is now in good health, minus 18 inches of his stature


