LONDON SPARRING CLUB.

ATHLETICS.

It is reported that Matsuda Sankichi, the well-known Japanese catfish-catcher, is a victim of galloping consumption.

At the annual games of the Canterbury Amateur Athletic Club, at Christchurch, New Zealand, wonderful hurdling powers were displayed by Mr. G. B. Shaw. He created a world's record in the quarter-mile hurdle race, and cleared the hurdle in 12 seconds, a high hurdle race faster than any amateur has yet done, and in the latter he ran a race as a best on record. In the 440-yard hurdle race, 10 hurdles, 3 feet 6 inches high, running steadily, he overtook his men, finishing in 1 minute 2 seconds, which is now the world's record.

In the 120-yard hurdle race, 10 hurdles 3 feet 6 inches high, the handicaps were all behind scratch. In this race Shaw was on the 25-yard mark, which was virtually a start. Shaw gave another magnificent performance, winning easily, and doing the 145 yards in 18 3/5 seconds. Shaw's time for the 120 yards was 12 2/5 seconds. The record is 16 seconds, and Shaw's time is every bit equal to it. All three timekeepers agreed to the 62 seconds for the 440 yards, and the distance was carefully measured.

Shaw is an old-time English hurdler, and ran third for the English championship of 1880, and won the grand international hurdle race in Paris, France.
