Fortune-teller—" You will be very poor until you are thirty-five years of age." Impecunious man (eagerly)— "And after then?" Fortune-teller— "You will get used to it."

RECTAL ALIMENTATION.— The following prescriptions are given by the *Journal des Praticiens*: As a nutritive enema:

Cod liver oil5 ozs.Yolk of one egg.Lime waterLime water

This mixture is sufficient for four or five enemata, which may be given during the course of a day. In other instances the following may be employed :

Cod liver oil5 ozs.Yolk of one egg.6 grs.Chloride of sodium40 grs.Water10 ozs.

This is also sufficient for four or five separate enemata. In still other cases, where it is desirable to use the hypophosphites, and the stomach will not retain them, the following rectal injection may be employed :

From four to six ounces of this liquid may be used as an injection. For dysentery:

Sulphate of quinine	10 grs.
Powdered ipecac root	5 grs.
Chloride of ammonium	10 grs.
Tincture of opium	
Distilled water	

Of this a small teaspoonful may be taken every four hours.—*American* Druggist.
