

S. Neil MacFarlane received his doctorate in International Relations at the University of Oxford where he was a Rhodes scholar from Quebec. He subsequently held research positions at the International Institute for Strategic Studies in London, at Harvard University's Centre for International Affairs and at the Institute of International Relations of the University of British Columbia. He is currently an assistant professor of Government at the University of Virginia. He is the author of *Superpower Rivalry and Third World Radicalism*, *Soviet Intervention in Third World Conflict* and a number of other scholarly monographs and articles.
