



Canada's fishing industry, Canada's oldest industry, stands to gain important benefits from the Canada-U.S. Free Trade Agreement. Canadian exporters will also benefit from the dispute settlement mechanism, as countervail and antidumping cases will be judged strictly in accordance with the law and all relevant facts.

Canada-wide social and regional development programs will remain intact and the Canada-U.S. Free Trade Agreement will ensure enhanced access for the Canadian fishing industry to the largest market in the world.
