ARTICLE 8

The Contracting Parties shall establish a Joint Economic Commission to meet alternately in each country, at the request of either Party, for consultation on the measures and means to be adopted for the consolidation and promotion of trade, economic and technical co-operation between them. To provide for avenues of continued consultation in the period of time between meetings of the full Joint Economic Commission, sub-committees established by the Commission may meet on a regular basis as required to further the objectives of this Agreement and report the result of such consultation to the next meeting of the Commission.

ARTICLE 9

- (a) This Agreement shall enter into force as of the date of the exchange of instruments of ratification according to the regulations in use in each country.
- (b) The duration of this Agreement is for three years commencing on the date it enters into force and shall be automatically renewed for consecutive periods of one year unless either of the Contracting Parties gives notice six months before expiration of the Agreement of its intention not to renew.
- (c) Upon the expiry of this Agreement contracts still under execution and signed when this Agreement was still in force or payments due in accordance with such contracts shall be governed by this Agreement.
