## The Secretary of State of Finland to the Ambassador of Canada

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of Your Excellency's Note No. 9 of 8 June, 1984, the English text of which reads as follows:

"1. I have the honour to refer to the Agreement Between The Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of Finland Concerning the Uses of Nuclear Material, Equipment, Facilities and Information Transferred Between Canada and Finland, signed at Helsinki, 5 March, 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the Agreement) and in particular to Article II(1) of the Agreement which states:

"(See Canadian Note of June 8, 1984)"

I have the honour to confirm that the Government of Finland agrees with the guidelines set forth in Your Excellency's Note and accepts that they should govern the reprocessing of the material subject to the Agreement and the storage and use of plutonium so obtained.

I have the honour further to confirm that the Government of Finland agrees that Your Excellency's Note and this reply shall constitute the agreement required by Article II(1) of the Agreement and that this agreement shall enter into force on the date of this Note.

Please accept, Your Excellency, the assurance of my highest consideration.
