

EXCHANGE OF NOTES (JANUARY 18, 1952) GIVING EFFECT TO THE CONVENTION BETWEEN HIS MAJESTY AND THE FEDERAL PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF AUSTRIA REGARDING LEGAL PROCEEDINGS IN CIVIL AND COMMERCIAL MATTERS SIGNED AT LONDON MARCH 31, 1931, AS BETWEEN CANADA AND AUSTRIA.

YOUR EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to the notes which were exchanged between Your Excellency and myself on the 28th June, 1951, on the subject of the Convention between His Majesty in respect of the United Kingdom and the Federal President of the Republic of Austria, regarding legal Proceedings in Civil and Commercial Matters signed at London on the 31st March, 1931*. The accession of Canada to the above-mentioned Convention was notified to the Austrian Government on the 1st July, 1935*.

At the instance of His Majesty's Government in Canada I have the honour to propose that effect shall be given to the aforesaid Convention, as from the date of this Exchange of Notes, in respect of Canada and that the Convention shall continue in force in accordance with the provisions of Article 15.
