

EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE  
GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SENEGAL CONSTITUTING AN  
AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE APPLICABILITY TO CANADA OF THE  
AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE GLOBAL ATMOSPHERIC RESEARCH  
PROGRAMME (GARP) AND THE RELATED PROTOCOL OF EXCHANGE

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement on GARP Atlantic Tropical Experiment (GATE) concluded between WMO, the Government of the Republic of Senegal and other member states participating in the experiment, which was done at Geneva June 27, 1973<sup>(1)</sup>, and to the related Protocol of Execution, done at Geneva December 28, 1973<sup>(1)</sup>, which constitutes an annex to the aforesaid Agreement.

Under the provisions of Section 17 (A) of the Agreement any member state of WMO wishing to become party to the Agreement and Protocol of Execution, for the purpose of participating in GARP Atlantic Tropical Experiment (GATE), is required to notify the Government of the Republic of Senegal accordingly.

I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the Government of Canada agrees to be a participating member state under the terms prescribed in the Agreement and Protocol of Execution. The name and address of the Canadian national agency which will act as the designated co-operating agency for purposes of the Agreement is as follows:

The Canadian Government intends to assign the Canadian weather ship, CCGS Quadra, to this research project. Quadra, according to present plans, will make use of the Port of Dakar four times during the period of the experiment for refuelling, resupply and rotation of personnel as required. As regards Article 2 of the Protocol of Execution, a provisional listing of Canadian experts who will participate in the experiment GATE has been provided by the Government of Canada through the channels of WMO. All individuals who have been thus identified will be based aboard CCGS Quadra except for in-port periods and transit times to and from Dakar.
