THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT HIS EXCELLENCY BRIGADIER GENERAL LUIS ERNESTO ORDONEZ PRESENTED TO THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL HIS LETTER OF CREDENCE AS AMBASSADOR EXTRAORDINARY AND PLENIPOTENTIARY OF COLUMBIA TO CANADA. THE CEREMONY TOOK PLACE AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE.

ROBERTSON, WAS IN ATTENDANCE ON THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL. THE CHIEF

GOVERNOR-GENERAL. THE AMBASSADOR WAS ACCOMPANIED BY COLONEL
MARIANO OSPINA, AIR ATTACHE, AND MR. MIGUEL SAMPER, FIRST
SECRETARY. MR. J.F. DELAUTE, SECRETARY TO THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL
(ADMINISTRATIVE) WAS ALSO PRESENT.

THE SERVED AS MILITARY ATTACHE IN BELGIUM, FRANCE, THE NETHERLANDS

A MEMBER OF THE MILITARY GOVERNMENT AND JUNTA.
