On motion of the Honorable Mr. Scott, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Pelletier,

it was

Resolved, That the Honorable Messieurs Aikins, Bellerose, Bureau, Carrall, Cochrane, Fabre, Ferrier, Haythorne, McLelan (Londonderry), Macfarlane, Penny, Reesor, Scott, Simpson and Wark, be appointed a Committee to superintend the Printing of this House during the present Session, and be instructed to act on behalf of this House with the Committee of the House of Commons, as a Joint Committee of both Houses, on the subject of Printing.

Ordered, That the said Resolution be communicated to the House of Commons

by one of the Masters in Chancery.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Scott, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Felletier,

it was Ordered, That the Honorable Messieurs Aikins, Alexander, Brown, Bureau, Campbell, Dickey, Macpherson, Miller, Pelletier, Penny, Power, Scott and Wilmot, be appointed a Committee to enquire into the best means to be adopted to obtain correct Reports of the Debates and Proceedings of the Senate, and for the publication of the same, and to report from time to time their views to the House.
