Except as hereinbefore is enacted and provided, the Act of the Parliament of Canada passed in the now last session thereof intituled "An Act for the temporary government of Rupert's Land and North-Western Territory when united with Canada," is hereby re-enacted, extended and continued in force until the 1st day of January, 1871, and until the end of the session of Parliament then next succeeding.
