believe to be the path in which the Church would guide her clergy, and to guard against making them wider through my own personal faults of disposition.

I have always been aware, that the best endeavours I could make to promote unity in the Church, was to seek after inward unity and peace in my own breast, because it is only by cherishing such graces that I can give consistency to my religious character, and cause its influence to pervade and penetrate the diocese, and shed abroad in it the power of faith and charity. 75
