Wheat dipped early on easy cables, but shorts ran the price up later under a variety of influences. The northwest reported deliveries light; the visible supply decreased, altho less than for the corresponding week a year ago; primary receipts were under the average of the previous week, and a toreign authority issued a bullish statement of probable European requirements, remarking that Russia and Roumania give slight hope of increasing their shipments before spring. The closing corn strength was an added bullish factor.

wheat were \$31,000 against 518,000 a year ago.

Argentine Corn Damaged.

Argentine news again held the centre of the stage in the consideration of the oorn market. Buenos Ayres advanced an extreme 2 cents and held on to it, and the local talent inclined to the belief that late seeded corn in Argentina had suffered visible damage. The wheat strength, in mid-session, helped corn here, but later took the leadership itself. Primary receipts were 200,000 bushels under those of a year ago. Important shorts were the best buyers and the close was within a shade of the top.

Oats were dull, May closing 1-8c up with corn, Spot advanced 1-4c in the sample market.

Provisions opened easy, but advanced early on buying by commission houses, of which grain houses did the most. Prices eased off toward the close on selling credited to packers.
