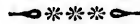

Letter from Mr. Daniel M'Kenzie to Lord Selkirk.

FORT WILLIAM, ON LAKE SUPERIOR,
October 10th, 1816.

MY LORD,

As the making up of exact Schedules of the property of the North-West Company, which I have sold to you at this place, will take more time, than can be afforded at this advanced period of the season, I have to request that your Lordship will cause them to be sent, as soon as ready, to Montreal; where I will add my signature. I am fully satisfied of the accuracy of the Inventories taken by Messrs. Pritchard, Kennedy and Spencer, and as no document can be found here for ascertaining the actual cost of the goods, I have no objection to the different articles being valued at the same prices, as in the Inventories made out in June last, or at those of the Proprietors' Tariff.
