From hence it is, that they have planted christianity, in the most distant parts of the globe. From their consequent successful labors, and greater experience, they are in due time, advanced to the station of bishops and superiors.

They are appointed to their various errands by the bifhop of the diocefe, and removed at his differentian, and upon the decease of a parish priest, another is immediately placed in the cure. If his administration is not acceptable, he is made the minister of some other place.

Difcords feldom break out with virulence between the clergy and their parithioners, and great reverence is paid to the prietthood as an office of divine appointment. Aaron when confecrated to the priefthood in the church of Ifreal, was not more revered, than the Catholic priefts are in all public performatces.
