### COL. FRED. DENISON DEAD.

MEMBER FOR WEST TORONTO  
CUMS TERSE MORNING.

After an illness of four months, during which more than once he was despaired of, Lieut.-Col. Denison of the Governor-General's Body Guards, and M.P. for West Toronto, died at his residence, Rushmore, at 115 this morning, in his 50th year.

A fortnight ago the gallant Colonel was reported considerably better, and was able to come down town and attend to official business. His malady, however, cancer of the stomach, admitted of no hope of permanent recovery, but it was not until early yesterday morning that the alarming symptoms recurred in such severity as to preclude hope. The members of the family were summoned, and the Colonel's many friends were apprised of the fast-approaching end.

The brilliant soldier-like qualities of the deceased, his whole-souled devotion to duty, whether on the field, in the courts, or in domestic life, are well known; but it was his gentility, urbanity and gentlemanly demeanor, with an assiduous consideration for others, that obtained for him the high esteem and great popularity he so long enjoyed.

Subjoined is the record of the deceased's career in each of the above capacities.

#### AN EVENTFUL CAREER.

Frederick Charles Denison was the second son of the late Col. George Taylor and Ann Dawson Denison and was born at Rushmore, near Toronto, on Nov. 22, 1846, the same house where he has just passed away. He was a direct descendant, a great grandson, of John Denison of Hedon, Yorkshire, England, who came to Canada in 1792, and who served in the York Militia, Toronto, in 1794. F. C. Denison was educated at first privately and when he was in his eleventh year, in 1857, entered Upper Canada College, where he remained until 1863. After leaving U.C.C. he entered upon the study of law, being called to the bar in 1870. He was one of the early graduates at the Military School in Toronto, having for one of his cotemporaries Lieut.-Col. James Mason, commanding the Royal Grenadiers. In 1865 the deceased was gazetted cornet in the Governor-General's Body Guard of Cavalry, a corps with which he had an hereditary connection, his father's grandfather before him having had command of that body. He was promoted lieutenant in December, 1867, and captain in 1872, major in 1876 and lieutenant-colonel in 1884.

In 1870, on the breaking out of the Red River disturbances, he accompanied Colonel James Macdonell, commanding the Royal Grenadiers, to the Canadian expedition sent to suppress the rebellion. As a military officer, or what might more fitly be termed Provincial A.I.C., in that capacity he displayed great zeal and ability, and was mentioned in despatches by Col. Wolsey.

Imperial Honors.

For his conduct in the Sudan Lieut.-Col. Denison received the English war medal, the Khedive's bronze star, was created C.M.G., was several times mentioned in despatches, and was specially mentioned in the British House of Commons by the Marquis of Salisbury when he moved the thanks of Parliament to the troops who had served throughout the campaign.

Before leaving Egypt Lieut.-Col. Denison was attacked with enteric fever and had a long and dangerous illness, from which he only slowly recovered, but eventually entirely regained his health.

As an Alderman.

Lieut.-Col. Denison represented St. Stephen's Ward in the City Council from 1878 until 1881 inclusive, was out of the Council in 1882 and was re-elected in 1883-84. In the latter year he was chairman of the Executive Committee of the Council, and in 1885 he was Mayor of Toronto in 1885 but for his absence in the Sudan he would have been painstaking and conscientious and earned the respect of all those he was brought into contact with.

Parliamentary Career.

On the dissolution of the Dominion House of Commons Lieut.-Col. Denison was elected for West Toronto and has represented that constituency since the 18th of July, 1884. He was a straight Conservative though he voted against his party in the decision on the fiscal policy of the country. Col. Denison was a Protectionist and boldly avowed it at times. He was right or wrong at all times, the Colonel had the courage of his opinions. In conversation with an old friend long before his death he said: "I am a Protectionist; if we are to be manufacturers at all, we must have our industries protected." In accordance with these sentiments the member for West Toronto always recorded his vote on all questions affecting the tariff.

### MINNIE MINCHEN'S DEATH.

A Coroner's Jury Says She Died from the Effects of an Illegal Operation.

Niagara Falls, Ont., April 14.—An inquiry was begun this evening into the circumstances surrounding the death of Minnie Minchen, Dr. S. E. Bines, testified that he was a widower, with five children. Deceased was his house-keeper. The first knowledge he had of her was on Thursday at noon, when his daughter told him of it. He used to employ her in the kitchen. Witness thought her trouble was uterine colic and gave her sedative medicine. At night the girl was no better. He did not see her after Thursday evening. On Saturday Dr. S. E. Bines came to his office and informed him of her death, and he sent for the police officials, that there might be a case. Hearing that she had been operated on, he thought the danger past. He was not certain the woman was pregnant.

Dr. Bines, who performed the post-mortem, swore that death resulted from an abortion, which had been performed by the deceased. He said that he must have followed within two or three hours. Dr. McGarry thought 24 hours might have elapsed.

The jury found that deceased met death by an abortion performed by some person other than herself, such person being unknown.

TAHT IRISH LAND BILL.

John Howard Parnell Says It is a Good Measure, as Also Say the New York, April 14.—John Howard Parnell, brother of the late Charles Stewart Parnell, is on a brief visit to this country. Mr. Parnell, who is a member of Parliament, discussed with a representative of the United Press to-day the merits of the new land bill, which Mr. Balfour, the Chief Secretary for Ireland, has introduced into the House of Commons.

"Balfour's bill," said Mr. Parnell, "has many good points, but, of course, it will never settle and was never meant to settle the Irish land question. No British Government will do that for the purchase of the land, which that problem can only be effected by an Irish Parliament sitting in Dublin.
