

Since this Account was closed, a small sum has been received by the Secretary, which, with interest due after 30th inst., will raise the total of net collections to about \$80,000.

Shortly after the Annual Meeting of the D. C. S. in 1868, the Committee of the Church Endowment Fund, as requested by that meeting, directed their Secretary to furnish to each Parish a statement of its indebtedness to this Fund; and a copy of such statement was accordingly forwarded to the Rectors of Parishes. Since the date of that Circular, 1st August, 1868—the following sums have been received from several Parishes:
