THE PIONEER AND HISTORICAL ASSOCIATION OF THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO, CANADA.

The Annual General Meeting of the Association was held in the Canadian Institute, Toronto, Wednesday, June 7th, 1893. The President, Rev. Dr. Scadding, in the chair.

The following delegates of affiliated societies were present: W. H. Doel and Wm. Rennie, from York Pioneer and Historical Society; Eli Crawford and Thos. Morphy, from Peel Pioneer and Historical Society; D. B. Read, Q.C., Grenville Pioneer and Historical Society; A. F. Hunter, Simcoe Pioneer and Historical Society, and Dr. Canniff, Historical Section of Canadian Institute, Toronto.

The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and adopted.

Secretary read the following report, which was adopted:

'There are at present seven Pioneer and Historical Societies in affiliation with the Provincial Association, viz.: York Pioneer and Historical Society, Peel Pioneer Society, Lundy's Lane Historical Society, Wentworth Pioneer and Historical Society, Grenville Pioneer and Historical Society, Simcoe Pioneer and Historical Society, Historical Section Canadian Institute, Toronto.

The celebration of 1892, in commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the establishment of the Province of Upper Canada, under the auspices of this Association, was carried out in a manner becoming the occasion.

On 20th April, 1892, a joint meeting of this Association and other Historical Societies decided to hold two centennial celebrations, one on the 16th July at Niagara, to commemorate the issuing of the Proclamation by Governor Simcoe declaring the electorial divisions of the Province of Upper Canada; and a second in Toronto, September 17th, at the new Provincial Parliament Buildings, to commemorate the opening of the first Parliament of Upper Canada.
