Washington, Sept. 24.—First steps looking to the fixing of prices for standard grades of raw cotton were taken yesterday by the government in the naming of two committees, one to investigate the entire cotton situation, and the other to control during the period of the inquiry the distribution of cotton by purchasing all of the staple needed by the United States and the Allies at prices to be approved by the president.

RAILWAY STRIKE BREAKS OUT AGAIN

South Wales Trouble Spreads and Situation is Reported to Be Serious

London, Sept. 24.—A sectional strike of railway men in South Wales, who are dissatisfied with the settlement of the dispute arrived at on last Thursday, was begun on Sunday in defiance of union leaders and spread to a serious extent today, dislocating traffic over a large area and compelling the idleness of thousands of mines and metal workers and seriously delaying the output and distribution of coal. The trouble threatens the complete disorganization of the South Wales industries.

James Henry Thomas, general secretary of the National Union of Railwaymen, has gone to Wales to try to effect a settlement. He told newspaper men that the situation was very serious, and that the leaders of the National Union were gravely concerned.
