J. W. Robertson Outlines Recommendations of Commission — What New Brunswick Needs — Province's Share of Proposed Dominion Subsidy

of the most important lectures delivered before the St. John Convention and one destined to have far-reaching effects was that given last evening by Dr. J. W. Robertson, C. M. G., LL. D., entitled "Development of Education for New Brunswick."

His lecture Dr. Robertson gave a shrewd summary, in condensed form, of the results of the work of the Commission on Industrial Training and Technical Education, of which he is chairman. He emphasized the need of special training for the men and women who do the work of the domain and did not hesitate to say plain and great is the lack of proper training or mechanics and preparation for work among farmers. It was for this reason that the commission recommended a system of education and training in connection with the public schools and supplemented by continuation schools for those who have to leave to go to work.

The commission is of the opinion that industrial training and technical education in order to be of the greatest benefit to individuals, to industrial development, to localities, to the several provinces, and to the dominion as a whole should be organized and maintained in accordance with the following principles:

1. It should be under provincial control and regulation.
2. It should receive financial support from individuals, from local authorities, from provincial governments, and from the dominion.
3. Provision should be made for active participation in its control, management and direction by individuals in the locality who would represent industries, employers and employees, agriculture, women's occupations, particularly house-keeping, business and organized education.
4. It should provide educational opportunities for those who have gone to work and also for those who are able to return and devote their time for some months or years, as the case may be, to a course or courses of instruction and training.
5. It should take provision to ensure, as far as practicable, equality of opportunity, agricultural and house-keeping occupations and for workers in such occupations.
6. It should be carried out in cordial co-operation with existing systems of education, and in such a way as to have the advantage of the use of existing buildings, equipment and teaching staff so far as these may be suitable and available.

Provincial Revenues Inadequate. The revenues of the several provinces for all purposes are derived, at the present time, to the extent of some \$10,000,000 from subsidies from the dominion. The royal commission recommends that in addition to any other subsidy that may be provided, the sum of \$2,000,000 per annum should go into a dominion development fund to be spent by local and provincial authorities co-operating with the dominion authorities for the purposes indicated. The dominion government of Canada.

The Royal Commission on Industrial Training and Technical Education visited 100 places in Canada, held 175 sessions to receive testimony and has transcripts of the evidence of 1,471 men and women. Some of those occupy the foremost positions in industries, agriculture, house-keeping, and educational work. The ends of the growing population of Canada as stated by these witnesses may be summarized as:

First—Hand-training and pre-vocational education in the common schools after the age of 12 to reveal the best of the child's ability to itself, to its parents and to its teacher.

Second—Something in the school classes to make boys and girls want to continue at school as long as they can.

Third—Some provision in the way of secondary industrial and technical education for those who can continue at school from 12 to 16.

Fourth—Continuation classes to be attended while young people are following some occupation to earn their living.

Fifth—Evening classes for workmen and workwomen.

Sixth—Middle technical schools to which men and women can come back for periods of from six months to two years after they have been working for some years.

In addition to these the witnesses presented the claims of the rural population and fishing population for schools specially adapted to their needs. All were agreed upon the necessity for and certain of the benefit from classes and schools for house-keeping occupations. Many witnesses recommended the establishment of correspondence study classes by central institutions in Canada.

The Underlying Principles. Means to be Used. The consideration of a policy for New Brunswick involves the examination of plan or means whereby development may be immediately carried forward along desirable lines. In a general sense word education includes vocational training but in the more specific meaning of the term vocational training means the development of education by institutions, modifications and extensions, hitherto the so-called educational ladder, right only one place for its top and where only a comparatively small number of men are required in the public interest. Hereafter the top of the ladder will be in every kind of institution where a man or woman is needed for industrial service in agricultural work, in industrial work, commercial work, or house-keeping work.

The institutions to be affected by this reorganization are elementary schools, secondary schools, and the higher institutions such as colleges and universities. The process of development all that good shall be conserved, only what is necessary should be added and provision made for all the people and all the occasions.

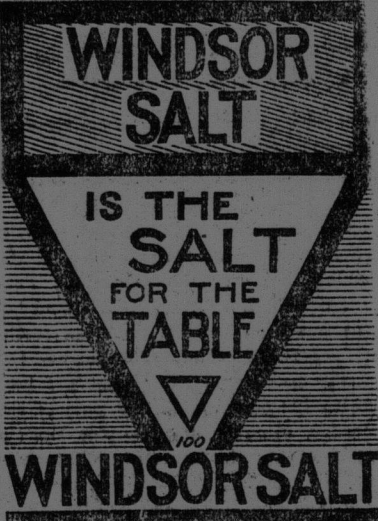

ment has already indicated its ability and readiness to co-operate with the provinces for development work as shown in the Agricultural Instruction set of 1912-13 whereby a sum aggregating \$10,000,000 was provided, the expenditure to be spread over a period of ten years.

For the Province.

The amounts which would be available to some of the places in New Brunswick for such educational development work under the recommendations of the commission would be, in round figures, as follows:

St. John city and county	\$21,000
Westmorland	18,000
York	12,000
Northumberland	12,000
Kings and Albert	12,000
Victoria and Madawaska	11,000
Kent	10,000
Charlotte	8,000
Queens and Sunbury	7,000
Restigouche	6,000

The total for New Brunswick would be about \$140,000.

The total amount coming to New Brunswick from such a source would, in round figures, be about \$200,000 per annum. All this would be in addition to the comparatively small amount recommended to be spent by the dominion government for a technical staff to advise the several provincial authorities as required, on special matters and to maintain a few central institutions such as would not be required for any province by itself.
