1. Moved by Rev. J. ELLIOTT, seconded by Mr. D. FRASER,

Resolved, That the Report now read by the Secretary be adopted, printed and circulated under the direction of the Committee. And that this meeting desires to record its firm belief in the Divine authority, permanent institution, and perpetual obligation of the Lord's Day.

2. Moved by Rev. R. V. ROGERS, seconded by Rev. T. BONE,

Resolved—That the Committee (if they deem it expedient), be empowered to invite a conference of Ministers and other friends of the Sabbath for the purpose of discussing the Sabbath question, and devising means for securing the due observance of the Lord's Day throughout the Dominion.
