McGirr, of the Indian Department, who was sent up west during the recent general elections ostensibly for the purpose of making a report in regard to matters pertaining to the St. Peter's band of Indians, made any such report, and, if so, will the Government submit it to Parliament? As the St. Peter's Indian band is located near Winnipeg, were Mr. McGirr's expenses to the Territories, at that time, paid?

1. Mr. William McGirr made a report on matters pertaining to the St. Peter's band of Indians.
2. The report will be submitted to Parliament if desired.
3. Mr. McGirr was paid no expenses to the Territories at the time referred to in the inquiry.
