Present System Haphazard.

Originally intended as a sort of propaganda, Sinn Fein contra sat a good while before any attempt was made by the central Sinn Fein authorities to establish a properly organized judicial system. These tribunals were, and still are, to a large extent haphanzed, meeting when it seemed good, trying such cases as looked like god advertising, inflicting sentences that bore no relation to one another or to any existing penal code. In parcitcular, great care was taken to try only cases that offered no difficulty. In all the criminal cases tried by Sinn Fein courts in May and June, the percentage of acquitials to convictions was only something like one in fifty. There were no regular judges appointed to sit in these courts, the parish priest, if he happened to be a Sinn Feiner, and one or more officers of the lish Volunteers occupying the bench.
