Perhaps the most no-vel scheme they have is the so-called Labor Army, whose ranks include every able-bodied inhabitant of the cognuty. The underlying principles of it is that every man above 20 and every woman above 18 shall contribute his or her proportionate share of labor to the reconstruction, development and improvement of the country. One group of workers, for example, give a destain part of their time to the build-ing of railways, bridges and roads, an-other to the drainage of lowlands or the development of the soil, a fourth to the study of governmental and admin-istrative problems, and so on. Another idea introduced by the pea-sants is the purchasterad sale by the government, at minimum prices, of all things needed for the ilie of the peo-




