MISS TRAVERSE IN "SPLENDID SIN"

Should Wife Keep a Secret From
Her Husband For Sake of
Another?

Lady Marion Chatham, of Chatham
Manor, England (Madeline Traverse)
the American wife of Sir Charles
Chatham, is most happy in the love
of her husband, yet both are unhappy
in their childlessness. But the lack
of a Chatham child is the secret joy
of old Dowager Lady St. Aubrey, who
covets the estate for her insipid son,
who will be the Chatham heir should
Sir Charles die without issue.

Proof of her husband's brilliant
record in public life, Lady Marion
speeds him on his way to fill a diplo-
matic mission in Egypt just as she wel-
comes to their home Stephen Hartley,
an American diplomatic agent, secretly
affianced to Gertrude, sixteen-year-
old sister of Sir Charles.

Marion's recognition of Hartley as

From Gertrude's tears Marion ques-
sions the girl's secret and follows Hartley
to London to urge on him the importan-
ce of immediate marriage with Gertrude.
Marion's mission works little good, as
Hartley has gone; and the malicious
old dowager, spying after Marion,
determines to use this visit to Hartley's
lodgings as evidence against her.

As the months pass Gertrude be-
comes more unhappy, and at last con-
fesses to Marion that she is to become
a mother. In utmost tenderness Lady
Marion shields the girl and sends word
for Hartley to return at once to England.
While Hartley is trying to break through
the Bolshevik lines he is badly wounded
and is unable to reach England till
after his child is born and Gertrude is
dead.

The young mother, passing out of
life as she gives a new life to the world,
begs Marion to take the baby boy and
guard him as if he were her own flesh
and blood.

Enlisting the doctor on her side,
Marion protects the name of the dead
child-mother by giving out the baby
as hers. Happy at last in a child to
satisfy her mother-love and the am-
bition of her husband, she coaxes Sir
Charles that an heir has been born to
Chatham.

The dowager, back from a continen-
tal tour, confronts Sir Charles—who
has returned home to see his wife and
child—with the malicious insinuation
that the child is Marion's and Har-
ley's. Following close upon the insinuation,
Sir Charles finds Hartley's name in
Marion's feet, and in a drowsy state is
about to admit him, when he is
arrested by the whole truth.

because of her splendid sin, then
goes to the dowager and crushes the
old lady's hopes forever by announcing
that the babe in Marion's arms is the
heir to Chatham.
