MISS TRAVERSE IN "SPLENDID SIN"

Should Wife Keep a Secret From Her Husband For Sake of Another?

Lady Marion Chatham, of Chatham Manor, England (Madeline Traverse) the American wife of Sir Charles Chatham, is most happy in the love of her husband, yet both are unhappy in their childlessness.
