

acted by the authority aforesaid, that when any Register so to be appointed shall die, be removed from or resign his office, and that within the space of one year from and after such death, removal or resignation, no misbehaviour shall appear to have been committed by such Register in the execution of his said office, then and in such case, at the end of the said year the recognizance entered into by his said Sureties shall become void and of no effect, as to such Sureties, to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

V. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that each of the Registers so appointed shall provide a bound blank book of strong paper, covered with calf or sheep skin or buckram, and from time to time as may be needful, other such Books (marking the first with the letter A and so on in alphabetical order) fit and proper for enregistering in manner and form as herein after expressed, all Notarial Acts or Deeds creating mortgages upon Houses, Lands and Hereditaments, situate and being within his District or Inferior District; and before any entry shall be made by any Register in any such book he shall present the same to one of the Justices of the Court of King's Bench
