

RYAN, *Hon* PATRICK GEORGE, J.P. (*Gloucester*.)

Parents born in Irel. B. at Bathurst, N.B., 9 May, 1838, and ed. there. M., 26 Jan., 1862, Margaret, dau. of Mr. John Murphy. Is a leather manufacturer. Has been a Municipal Councillor for Caraquet; Warden of the Municipality of Gloucester and Chairman of the Pilotage Commission for the dist. of Caraquet. First returned to Ho. of Assem., Feb., 1876; re-elected at g.e., 1878 and 1882. Apptd. a mem. of Ex. Council and Chief Commr. of Board of Works, 3 March, 1883. Re-elected by acclamation, 26 March, 1883, and re-elected at g.e., 1886 and 1890. A Liberal.—*Caraquet, N.B.*

STOCKTON, ALFRED AUGUSTUS, Q.C., D.C.L., Ph. D., LL.D. (*St. John County*.)

Family descended from Richard Stockton, who emigrated from Cheshire, Eng. in 1660, settled in Long Island, N.Y., and subsequently removed to Princeton, New Jersey, where he took up large grants of land. Great grandfather served under the Crown in the war of the Revolution, and at its close came to N.B. and settled in King's Co., being one of the original grantees of the city of St. John. Eldest s. of the late W. Stockton, Esq., of Sussex, and Sarah, dau. of the late Robert Oldfield. B. at Stockholm, King's Co. N.B., 2 Nov., 1842. Ed. at Mount Allison Coll., where he graduated B. A. in 1864, and M. A. in 1867. Also graduated LL.D. at Victoria Univ., Cobourg, Ont., 1887; Ph. D. at Ill. Wesleyan Univ. in 1883, and received the degree of D. C. L. from Mount Allison Coll. in 1884. M., 5 Sept., 1871, Amelia, dau. of Rev. H. Pickard D.D., of Sackville, N.B. Called to the Bar, N. B., Trinity Term, 1868. Apptd. Q. C. by Dom.
