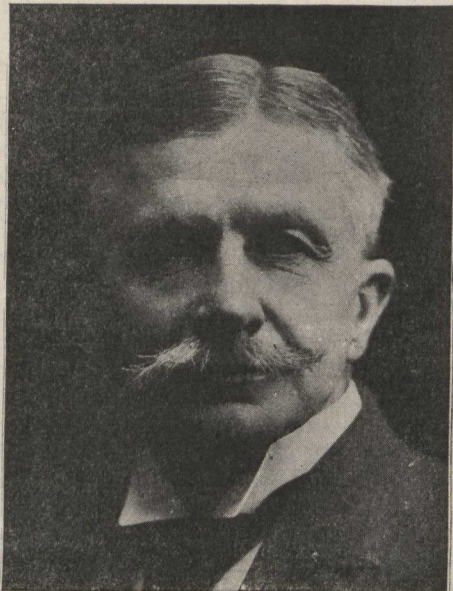


Dr. Fernow Passes On
