

ANOTHER DAY OF DEFEAT.

THE UNITED STATES CURLEURS RALLY BEATEN BY THE CANADIANS.

A score of 600 to 418—Manager Cushman's "Ten Strike"—Joe Baker at Pictou—Carriers at the Park Toboggan Slide—General Sporting Notes.

On each of the curling rinks yesterday played the curling rink of the United States. In not one of them were the United States clubs successful. "Beaten along the whole line" apply to the situation.

In the morning they encountered the Four Brothers' Club, to whom they had to succumb. Then Milwaukee, the present holders of the Gordon Medal, one of the most valued trophies secured by United States clubs, were beaten by three rinks of the Four Brothers' Club for a Grand National Curling Club Medal, which should have been played for last year. At the Mutual street rink the Robert Davies Medal was won by the Toronto Canadians, the strong representatives of Buffalo being their opponents.

In the afternoon the New York State clubs, comprising nineteen rinks, were defeated by the Toronto Granite men. A great deal of interest was taken in this match, which attracted many visitors, among whom were His Honor Lieut.-Gov. Robinson. At the Adelaide street rink, Jersey City, was taken into camp by a rink of the Toronto Club, as well as the three Milwaukee rinks.

At the Adelaide rink this morning play will commence at 10 o'clock. The competition is open to the natives of any one county of Scotland, and the medal is now held by Mr. G. H. Gillespie of Hamilton for Lanarkshire. The challenges are Sterling and Lanarkshire. Each county will present two rinks.

At Mutual street rink. Yesterday morning the first match was played for the Davies prize, a silver cup, given by Mr. Robert Davies of the Dominion Brewery.
