UNB, STU COUNCILS SUPPORT RALLY AT THE GALLERY ::: 1000 MAY TURN OUT

SRC President Ken Carty issues statement

In a statement recorded by Radio, UNB, SRC President Kenneth Carty declared full support of the march to the Legislature. The protest against increases in student fees which were not accompanied by Covernment grants is being organized by a group of "public-minded students" Students from UNB and St. Thomas University will participate in the protest march from the student centre to the Legislative assembly tomorrow.

The new time for the assembly at the Student Centre is 2:30, not 3:00 as previously stated.

In his statement, Carty said: "The presidents of the student councils of the Maritime universities met last Saturday night to discuss the matter and issued a strongly worded protest to the Governments of the provinces and the Country.

"As a result of this, the leaders of the Opposition in both House of Commons and the N.B. Legislature have brought this to the Houses concerned. Ar. Sherwood has given notice that he will introduce a motion calling on the provincial Government to increase financial aid to the universities!

"A number of students at UNE have planned a protest march to the Legislature .... to gather at the Student Centre at 2:30 on Friday and leave for the Legislature soon after".

"I invite all students who object to the fee raise to take part in this protest"

"The plan is for the students upon reaching the Legislature to fill the galleries so their presence will be felt during the debate!

"The murch <u>must</u> be orderly, peaceful and dignified. ... the students ... must be well dressed and serious."

"To have an effect and achieve the desired publicity there must be a substantial number of students present."
