Camp Borden, Ont.	April 1/40		Wing Commander Grant and three treasury officers, and Mr. Trott, messing prospect visited Station. Treasury officers becoming acquainted with Air Force procedure. No.1 runway cleared to 100 foot width. Air Compressor used on aerodrome to break through frozen surface and provide drainage for water lying on surface in pools.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	April 2/40		Aerodrome much improved and flying carried out without mishap. Major Sir Frederick Banting and Lt. Franks, R.C.A.M.C. visited station in connection with research work.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	April 3/40		F/O Sparrow visited Station in connection with aerodrome during break-up period, and also regarding snow rollers, tractors, loaders, etc. Also took up matter of electric flare paths revolving beacon and ceiling projector.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	April 4/40		Captain Gillan of Pay Corps visited Station.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	April 5/40		Squadron Leader Lacey with party of 21 other ranks as Mobile Repair Party reported at noon. Air Navigation and Reconnaissance School moved to this Station from Malton Airport today, bringing 12 officers and 15 Airmen and 4 Noresman Aircraft, to carry out night cross country training. Wing Commander Carr-Harris, Squadron Leader Critchley and Flight Lieutenant West visited Station. Arrived by air.
