

The Govr in Council by act 1887 may appoint the "Solv. Genl. of Law" who shall assist the minister of justice in the counsel work of the department of justice. He may hold a seat in either house provided he is elected while he holds such office, & is not otherwise disqualified

- (4) regulate carriage of the mails - letters newspapers packages etc. to see that newspapers publications excepted are not sent, des
  - (5) distribute postage stamps etc.
  - (6) make postal arrangements with other countries
