A Rural Mail Delivery route has been established from Domremy to serve a considerable district east and north of that town.

A tri-weekly postal car service on trains 75 and 76, C.N.R. between Prince Albert and North Battleford, 131 miles, was established as from the 2nd July, 1928, superseding a tri-weekly service by baggage car.

The baggage car service between Prince Albert and Saskatoon, train 8, C.N.R., was increased from 6 to 7 times per week, one way, 87 miles, effective 9th March, 1929.
