Prime Minister, Ottawa -

Dear Mr Meighen - I am just in receipt of your favor of the 12th Inst. If I have overstated your position I regret it but if I have been mistaken I would like to know where I stand - after I left you Dr Reid met me in the Chateau and stated that if I wished one of the two judgeships I should write you not later than last Saturday - This I promised to do. I did not discuss with him my wish to be appointed to the Senate because I thought he was an applicant therefor. Dr Reid did not say that what he told me was in confidence, otherwise I should not have mentioned the incident. I naturally concluded my claims had been discussed with favorable results - I still would prefer an appointment to the Senate although the emoluments are \$5000⁰⁰ per
