The Prime Minister, this morning, asked me to tell Mr. Hunter that, yesterday, he had asked Mr. Cardin to arrange with Mr. Brunet to take over the uncompleted commission of Tait Mackenzie for the Doughty Memorial. Mr. King indicated he had asked that Brunet come up to Ottawa. I passed this information on to Mr. Hunter whose Minister was ^{absent} out of town and had not spoken to him before leaving. He will discuss it with Mr. Cardin immediately upon his return, Monday.
