Sir

I have to inform you that
I wrote to you yesterday as follows:-
"His clearance of timber cut on
White Fish Lake Reserve past season.
"Question of measurement will be
settled later."

In explanation of the above
I may state that the Department has
decided not to allow the mode of
measurement adopted by the Indians
of the White Fish Lake Reserve as
regards the past season cut to
stand in the way of a clearance
being given for his timber, all other
things
