

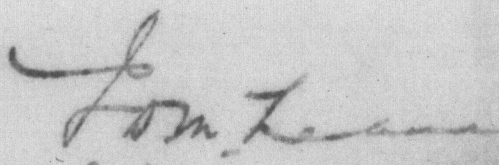
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Ottawa 31st October, 1902.

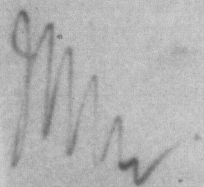
