Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letters of the 18th and 26th July last, in connection with the transfer of Lot II, Comandeu St. Maniwaki, from Joseph Poulin to Mortimer N. Cummings, which you recommend should be made but before this can be done, it will be necessary for you to obtain an Assignment from Joseph Poulin to Mr. Cummings covering this property, accompanied by the usual fee of \$1.00 for registration.


With reference to your letter of the 31st July, in which you state that Lot 51, Pakinawatik St. was seized through the Courts for a debt owed by Joseph Poulin, who occupied the Lot, and that the Court had paid the balance due on the property, I have to inform you that as it stands on the Books of the Department in the name of John Fester, no money should be accepted by you, unless paid on his behalf.
