
Ottawa, Jan. 2, 1914.

Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo and note that it has been decided to raise the bridge seats for the bridge over Boston Creek between Concessions 2 and 3, Tuscarora and it is recommended that the girder bridge be adopted. This is in accordance with the views of the Department as sent you in letter of Nov. 21, last. The Inspector of Works should arrange to have the bridge seats raised to a sufficient height accordingly.

I have to refer you to letter of Nov. 6, last, and to request you to be good enough to state, as requested therein, whether tenders were called for generally or was the Hamilton Bridge Works Company the only firm requested to name a price.
